Dry the Crawl Space

Mold remediation protocol requires a space have humidity under 60% and the wood be dry below 20%. Any company not doing this risks the mold growing back.

2



HEPA, Negative Air, HVAC Off

Another part of mold remediation protocol is putting the space under negative pressure, installing a HEPA air scrubber and turning off the HVAC. All to prevent cross contamination.

3



Remove the Mold First

Every mold disinfectant label requires mold to be removed. Dead mold is an allergen & food source for mold & cockroaches. Soda blasting-the greenest way to remove mold.

4



Apply Green/Safe Mold Products

The disinfectant should not be more toxic than the mold itself. This is why we use food grade sodium bicarbonate to remove mold and peroxide to kill the root of the mold.

5



10-Year Mold Prevention Warranty

The best way to keep mold away is with a dehumidifier and our moisture resistant mold preventative applied to the subfloor and joists of the crawl space or basement.
